About the Event

Brokers for Kids is a year-long contest involving valley commercial real estate teams in a fundraising drive that culminates with the Brokers for Kids annual Olympiad Challenge. The fundraising part of the competition involves the teams raising money throughout the year from clients, customers, employees and other sources. The team that raises the most money is awarded the coveted Broker's Cup.

Teams also compete for the Olympiad Championship in a series of fun physical challenges at the end of the fundraising competition. Currently, the Olympiad competition is held at in the Amphitheatre area of Tempe Town Lake. Each team/company fields a team of eight men and women that compete in various events, including volleyball, bocce ball, baggo and football toss.

This good-natured competition benefits at risk children who face issues that even the strongest, most mature adult would find challenging. The children's issues often range from physical and mental abuse, severe burns, debilitating diseases, and "at risk" environments that encumber their chances for success and sometimes survival. The primary beneficiary of Brokers for Kids is Boys Hope Girls Hope, an organization that provides scholarships to underprivileged kids in both community based and residency based programs, ensuring a good education and a start towards a college education. A percentage of the fundraising is donated to charity of choice of the Brokers Cup winner.
